- Reports
 - Principal's Report – Erin had notes from Mr. Bergholtz who was not present.
 - Pep rally was successful in getting kids pumped up to raise funds
 - Toy sale – volunteers still needed. Mr. Bergholtz is set to ask 6th graders
 - Delegate assembly for School Board Election – 4 of 7 seats are up for election this year. Erin is to send out information for getting involved so we can circulate.
 - Parent/teacher conferences will be 11/19. Electronic sign-up. 1st Priority goes to teacher's request but then open to everyone.
 - President's Report – Erin Shanahan
 - PSCC – Positive School Climate Committee
 - Chick-Chat is now Compass for Girls – the committee needs a new chair (March 3rd).
 - Talent Show – every other year schedule. We need to establish a program format.
 - Treasurer's Report
 - \$8,500 raised already this year
 - \$4,400 (without expenses taken out) was raised from Trivia Night
 - Toy Sale and Boosterthon will be our major fundraising opportunities for the year
- Larger Projects for the Year
 - Boosterthon – discussed decision for gym items
 - Rock wall – install/pads = under \$10K
 - Adjustable basketball hoops = \$1K - \$1,500 each. FR would like at least 4 of them
 - Volleyball system (nets, poles) = \$3,500 - \$4K/net. FR would need 2.
 - Crash mats = \$1K - \$1,500/each. Springboard = \$900-\$1K
 - Kris has not yet received grant submissions yet. Deadline was 10/15. It is possible that Mr. Bergholtz has received them – Kris will follow up.
- New Completed Reports
 - School Supplies – Janis
 - Decision was made to move to Shane's Kits moving forward. They are a local company and are priced cheaper. A 1 year contract has been signed.
 - Spiritwear – orders have been distributed
 - Trivia Night – Kathy Smolen
 - Successful night. Looking into possible online payment for next year.
